


Promoting fair migration

At the International Labour Conference in 2014, the ILO Director-General proposed a global Fair Migration Agenda, and made fair recruitment one of its main pillars. In response, the ILO launched a global "Fair Recruitment Initiative" to (a) help prevent trafficking in persons and forced labour; and (b) protect the rights of workers, including migrant workers, from abusive and fraudulent practices during the recruitment process.
