This article analyses gendered trends in the labour markets of eight European countries, decomposing quarterly changes in labour participation of women and men and in employment by sector. The “he-cession to sh(e)-austerity” scenario is not observed in all countries.

Child labour measurement: Whom should we ask? International Labour Review, 2018/2

Funding decisions to support vulnerable children are tied to child labour statistics, hence the importance of an accurate measurement. The author analyses whether the type of respondent plays an important role in explaining variations in child labour statistics. Using data from two sites in Tanzania, the analysis shows that “whom we ask” matters considerably when estimating the prevalence of child labour.

Enforcement matters: The effective regulation of labour. International Labour Review, 2018/3

The distinction between *de jure* and *de facto* regulation is well understood in theory, but has rarely been applied to cross-country empirical work on the impact of labour regulation on labour market outcomes for lack of data. This article provides new cross-country measures of labour law enforcement and

evidence of a negative correlation between stringency and intensity of enforcement. Previous results concerning the consequences of labour regulation and the legal origins theory no longer hold when a measure of effective labour regulation is used.




Trade union action on decent work for persons with disabilities. A global overview

However, disabled people rarely fulfil their legitimate social and economic aspirations or exercise their rights to access decent employment, both in the public and the private sector.


