







Future of regional cooperation in Asia and the Pacific

The health foundation COVID-19 survey - second poll: A report of survey findings

Awareness of the government's contact tracing app has increased since May from 36 per cent knowing a great deal or fair amount in May to 47 per cent in July, although over half (53 per cent) know just a little, have

only heard of, or know nothing about the app. When given no information about the app, just over half of the public (52 per cent) say they would download it. There is no difference in reported likelihood to download the app depending on whether a decentralised or centralised version of the app.


Macroeconomic stabilization in the digital age
