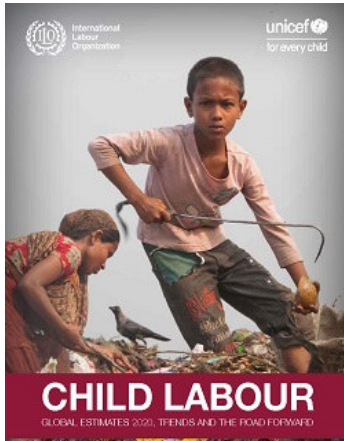

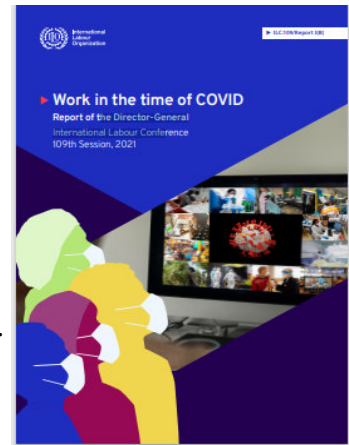
## Work in the time of COVID: Report of the Director-General. ILC-109th Session, 2021

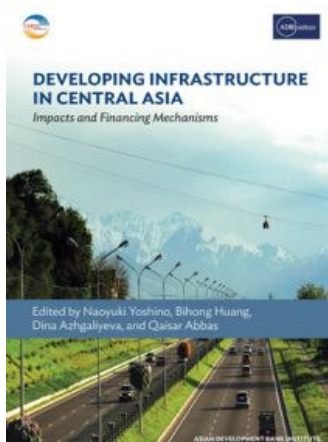
