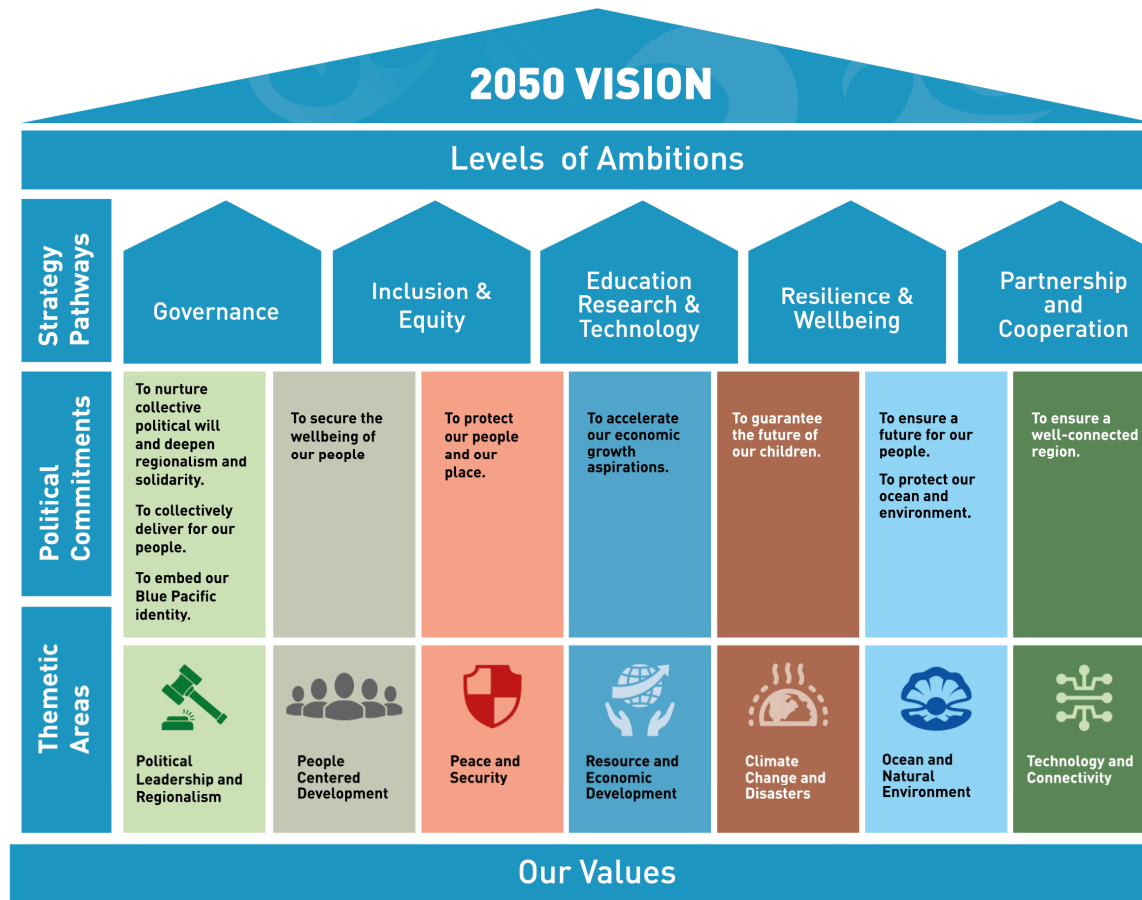
Key Values
