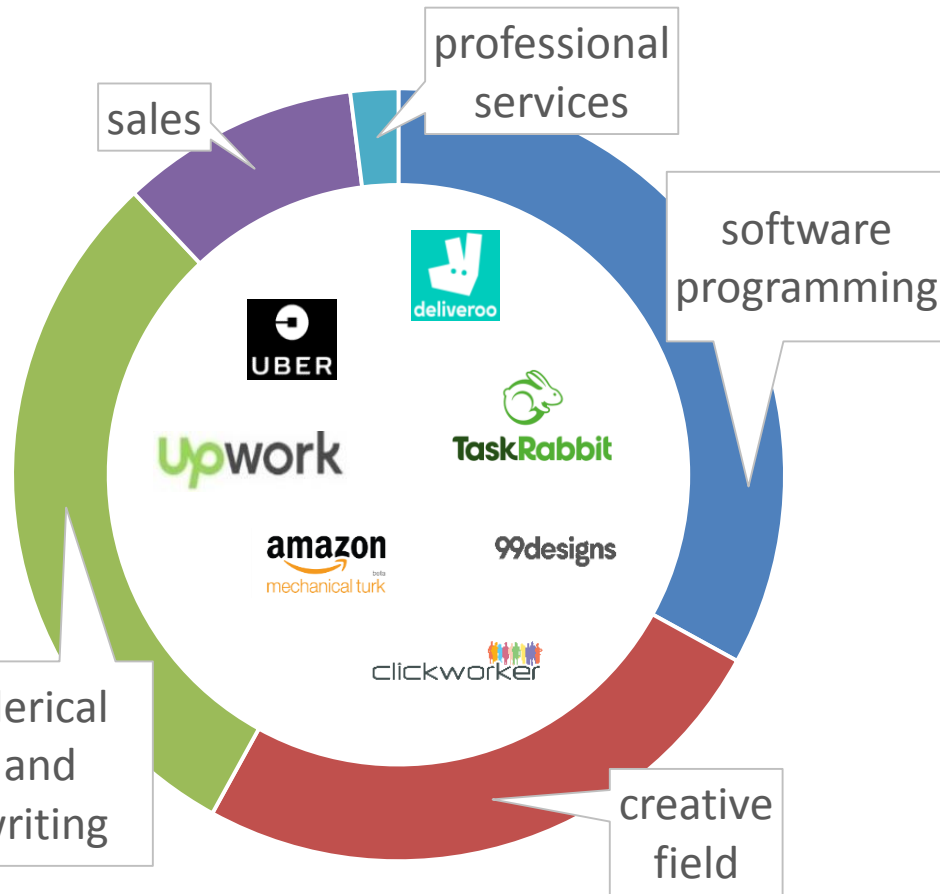

across 75 countries

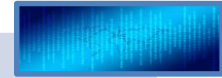

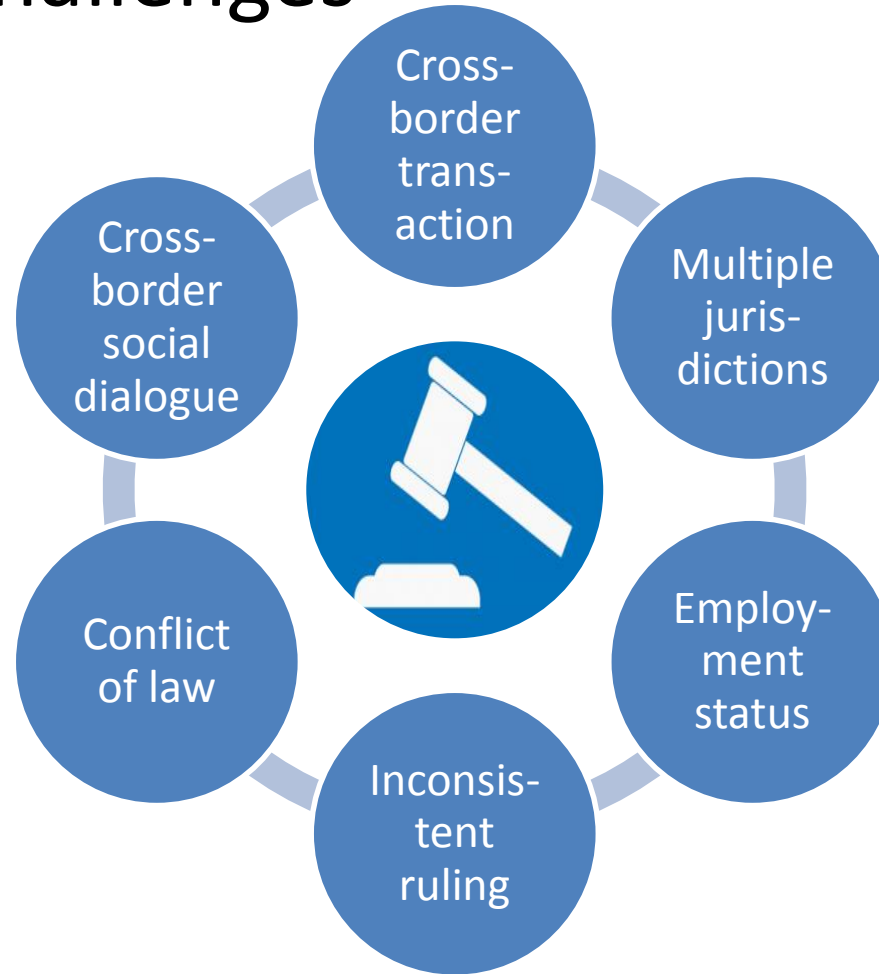

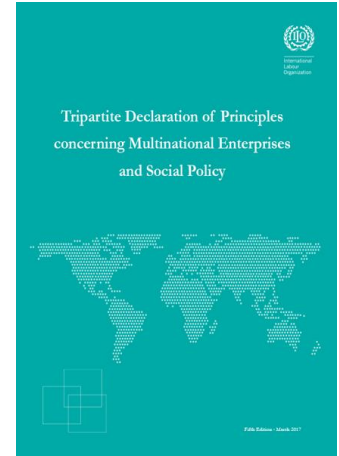

- Tripartite Declaration of Principles concerning Multinational Enterprises and Social Policy (MNE Declaration), 2017

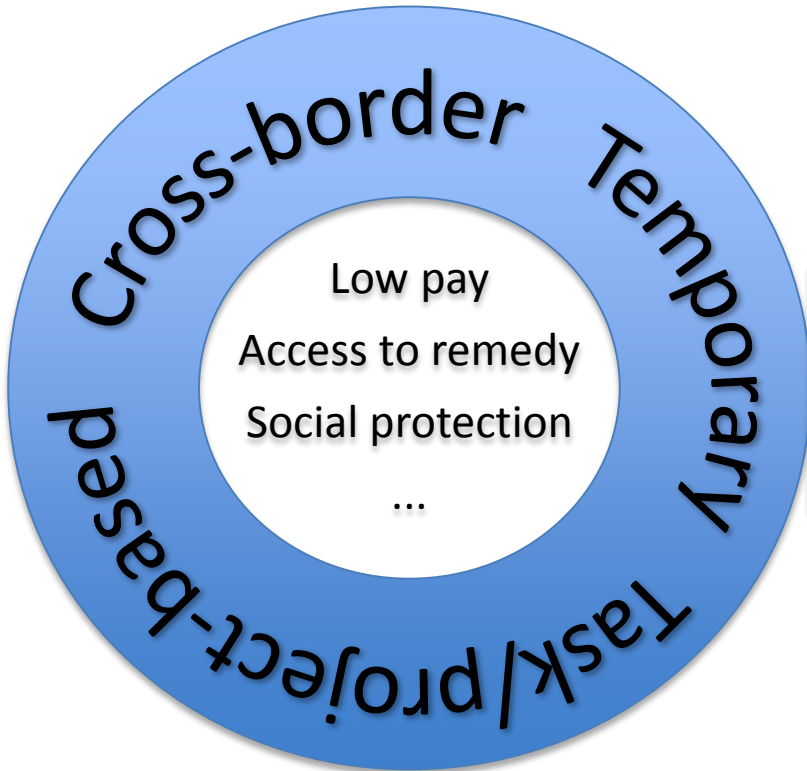
