Access to the ILO

From Geneva Airport

The 28 bus runs from Geneva Airport (Cointrin) to the ILO. The journey takes about 15 minutes and buses leave approximately every 20 minutes. Take the bus with the destination “Jardin Botanique”, and get off at the “BIT” bus stop. The price of the ticket is currently 3 CHF. Taxis charge in the region from 35 to 45 CHF for the trip.

From Geneva city centre

The F and 8 buses link Geneva train station, Cornavin, directly to the ILO (BIT stop), though the No. 8 bus terminates one stop earlier on Saturdays and Sundays, leaving a five-minute walk to reach the Organization.

Bus passes

All participants staying at hotels in Geneva can benefit from a free Geneva transport card. The personal, non-transferable card is issued on registration at the place of residence, and entitles its holder to use the entire public transport network without restriction (bus, train and boat). It is valid for the duration of the stay in Geneva, including the day of departure. The aim of this initiative by the Geneva authorities is to promote sustainable development by encouraging the use of collective transport.

For those participants not staying at hotels in Geneva, bus cards may be purchased from newsagents, tobacconists and TPG kiosks in Geneva.

By car

At the P.1 level of the ILO car park there are places for participants.

Access to the ILO building

Please note that due to increased security procedures and on-going renovations of the ILO building, access to the ILO is restricted. Participants should bring their own valid identification (passport or national identity card).

All participants arriving on **Tuesday, 6 March**, by car should follow the signs to the visitors' parking P.1 and from there, the signs indicating **“Door 4”**. Participants arriving by taxi should request the taxi driver to drop them off at **Door 4**, while participants arriving by bus should follow the signs from the bus stop to the ILO and follow the signs to **Door 4** (R2 south level).

At the Security desk, a staff member of the ILO Library will welcome participants from **1:30 p.m.** and provide them with an entry badge to the building. The entry badge contains a microchip that allows you to enter and exit the building during the meeting.

Upon their departure, participants are kindly requested to drop their entry badges in a designated badge return box placed after the gates, so they can be reused.
