GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ACCREDITED MEDIA

MEDIA CENTER

- The Media Center will be open as of Sunday, June 14th and is located in **Room XVI at the Palais des Nations** (behind the plenary hall on the 5th floor, Bldg A).
- The Media Center is equipped with 2 international telephone lines, 8 computers, a printer, internet access for portable computers via Wifi, earphones, access to photocopiers.
- The Media Center will be equipped with a screen showing live transmission of the plenary sessions.
- The Media team for the ILC/Global Jobs Summit is located just outside the Media Center in offices A561, A563 & A565.

PRESS CONFERENCE ROOM

- The Press Conference room is located in Room III at the Palais.
- Press conferences will be announced in the Media Center, in the *Daily Information Note for Media*, and via the public address system in the UN correspondents' offices at the Palais.

PRESS ACCESS TO THE PRESS GALLERY AND PLENARY HALL DURING THE GLOBAL JOBS SUMMIT

- The Press Gallery is located on the 6th floor of the plenary hall in a specially marked off section.
- All journalists, photographers and videographers **must be in possession of an ILC press badge** (orange) to access the press gallery.
- Access to the plenary floor is limited to ILO cameras and designated pool cameras.

BROADCASTING

- Only ILO cameras and one official pool camera per accompanying delegation for visiting Heads of State or Government will be allowed on the floor of the plenary hall during the Global Jobs Summit.
- Cameras must remain in fixed position during presentations by Heads of State/Government.
- Additional cameras are permitted in the 2 lateral galleries on the 5th floor of the plenary hall. TV or radio journalists are requested to not block the view of nearby delegates nor to occupy delegate seats.
- Audio multiplex boxes with XLR plugs are available in the plenary hall on both lateral galleries on the 5th floor (same floor level as the Media Center).
