► Consultancy service to support SIYB trainers' certification

The International Labour Organisation (ILO) is part of a partnership with UNHCR, UNICEF, WB and IFC, known as PROSPECTS, that is working to promote Inclusive Jobs and Education for Host Communities, Refugees and other Forcibly Displaced Persons in Uganda.

Under the partnership, ILO's work includes enhancing the local economic development of three refugee hosting districts of Arua, Madi-Okollo and Isingiro through enterprise development. The project targets refugees and host communities in these districts.

The ILO has well established enterprise development tools and last year, one of the tools, Start and Improve Your Business (SIYB), was introduced to the target districts through a Training of Trainers (TOT). A total of 39 participants- 19 in Arua and 20 in Isingiro- attended the training.

To qualify as trainers, the TOT participants are required to conduct at least one training of entrepreneurs under supervision of an SIYB master trainer, previously certified by ILO.

The ILO is looking for organisations, which have the capacity to manage the training of entrepreneurs and provide SIYB master trainers to supervise the 'candidate trainers' in the three districts. The selected organisations will work with the 'candidate trainers' to ensure that inclusive targeting of entrepreneurs is done and the government's SOPs to control the spread of Covid-19 are observed during the training workshops.
