MAP project overview

- ▶ **Main objective:** To develop a global methodology to strengthen countries' capacity to self-monitor progress towards decent work
- ▶ **4-year project:** 2009 – 2012
- ▶ **Covers 10 countries globally**
 - **Asia:** Bangladesh, Cambodia, Indonesia
 - **Africa:** Niger, Zambia
 - **Europe:** Ukraine
 - **Latin America:** Brazil and Peru
 - Two additional countries (one in **Asia**)
- ▶ **Partner** with government agencies, workers' and employers' organizations and research institutions



Background MAP project activities

▶ Preparation of background country studies

- Identifies DWI availability and gaps
- Recommendations to strengthen national DWI system
- **Bangladesh** and **Indonesia** studies completed in Q2 2010

▶ National tripartite consultation workshops

- Identify priority decent work indicators for national monitoring
 - National policy frameworks and DWCP
 - Monitoring crisis impact and recovery
- Prioritize areas for data collection and analysis
- **Indonesia** (March 2010): DWCP, Medium-Term Development Plan and Global Jobs Pact
- **Bangladesh** (April 2010): DWCP, 5-year Development Plan



MAP project activities under discussion

- ▶ **Enhance statistical instruments and collection of data to measure decent work**
 - **Cambodia** Labour Force Survey planned for 2010/11
 - Designed and piloted in December 2009
 - Technical assistance through ILO/STATISTICS, ILO/EC MAP, ILO/IPEC, ILO/Bangkok
 - Covers child labour, wages, OSH, disability and unionization
 - **Bangladesh** (2010/11)
 - Capacity-building and support for analysis of ISS and LFS
 - Strengthen administrative records
 - **Indonesia** (2010/11)
 - Inclusion of DW questions in LFS and establishment surveys
 - Strengthen administrative records



Strengthening data analysis on decent work

▶ Decent Work Country Profiles

- Preparation of in-depth country studies on decent work
- Data compilation of decent work indicators from NSOs and different ministries
- Policy-oriented analysis of trends and existing legal and policy framework
- **Indonesia** (Q3 2010); **Bangladesh** (after LFS 2009/10); **Cambodia** (after LFS 2010)

▶ National policy forums to disseminate and discuss country profiles (Q3 2011)

▶ Publication of country profiles and media campaign



Other MAP project activities

▶ Regional activities in Asia

- Regional MAP workshop (June 2010)
- Regional training and knowledge-sharing workshop (Q3/Q4 2011)

▶ Global activities

- Global conference on measuring decent work (Q4 2010)
- Development of global database of decent work indicators
- Production of manual and toolkit on the global methodology to self-monitor and self-assess progress towards decent work
