- 1.7: proportion of own-account and contributing family workers in total employment.

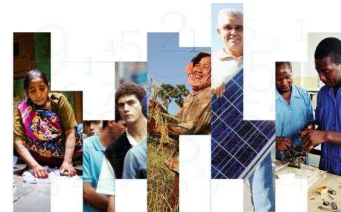
Before: MDG 3 (Promote gender equality and empower women):
