Country-level results

Constituents collect and disseminate new country-level data as per the resolution concerning statistics of work, employment and labour underutilization adopted by the 19th International Conference of Labour Statisticians

- **Azerbaijan:** Support to planning of new LFS
- **Moldova:** participated in the ILO programme of Labour Force Survey (LFS) pilot studies.
- **Tajikistan:** provided support and guidance to the Agency of Statistics and the Ministry of Labour, Migration and Employment on modernizing the LMI system
- **Kyrgyzstan:** supported the constituents in participating in Waves 1 and 2 of Phase I of the ILO Pilot LFS Programme, including on improved data collection processes
