The adoption of Resolution I of the 19th ICLS created many challenges for both producers and users of statistics alike. These challenges span across the full statistical life cycle. Among the different areas requiring attention, a solid communications strategy is a fundamental part of any implementation plan and will be critical at different stages of the process.
