Source: Data have been collected from national accounts (NA), national labour force surveys (LFS), establishment censuses (EC), establishment surveys (ES), administrative records (AR) and official estimates, as reported in their original sources. For OECD STAN Database, information comes from national accounts, industry surveys and censuses and the source estimates.

Sectors are classified according to ISIC Rev.3, as reported in their original sources. Sum of individual countries may not equal the total due to rounding, or other adjustments introduced by the original source.

Notes: ¹ Paid employment comprises all those workers who hold "paid employment jobs". These are jobs where the incumbents hold explicit (written or oral) or implicit employment contracts which give them a basic remuneration that is not directly dependent upon the revenue of the unit for which they work (this unit can be a corporation, a non-profit institution, a government unit or a household). Some or all of the tools, capital equipment, information systems and/or premises used by the incumbents may be owned by others, and the incumbents may work under direct supervision of, or according to strict guidelines set by the owner(s) or persons in the owners' employment. Persons in "paid employment jobs" are typically remunerated by wages and salaries, but may be paid by commission from sales, by piece-rates, bonuses or in-kind payments such as food, housing or training.

² Total employment refers to all people above a specific age who during a specified brief period, either one week or one day, were in the following categories: (a) "paid employment", whether at work (i.e., persons who during the reference period performed some work -at least one hour- for wage or salary, in cash or in kind); or "with a job but not at work" (i.e., persons who, having already worked in their present job, were temporarily not at work during the reference period and had a formal attachment to their job); and (b) "self-employment", whether "at work" (i.e., persons who during the reference period performed some work for profit or family gain, in cash or in kind); or "with an enterprise but not at work".
