WHO

WHO ATTENDS THIS COURSE?

The course is designed for representatives of governments and employers' and workers' organizations responsible for or with a demonstrated strong interest in policies related to socio-economic development, foreign direct investment and the operations of multinational enterprises (MNEs).

Course learning materials and tuition will be offered online in English. The following requirements are therefore essential to participate in this course:

- The ability to use and access a computer with internet
- Working knowledge of written English

WHAT WILL I LEARN?

Participants get up-to-date information, as well as the chance to interact virtually with peers and staff from ILO on

- How to deal with the challenges that enterprises, governments, and employers' and workers' organizations face in achieving sustainable and responsible business practices
- The aim, approach, principles and operational tools of the ILO's MNE Declaration
- The actions taken by different governments, enterprises, employers' and workers' organizations to stimulate enterprises for the realization of decent work

WHAT WILL I BE ABLE TO DO?

- Advise on policies, strategies and actions to maximize the positive contribution of MNEs to economic and social progress (foreign direct investment and global supply chains)
- Design actions basedon the different roles of governments, employers' and workers' organizations, and enterprises in promoting inclusive, responsible and sustainable business practices

WHY

WHY SHOULD I JOIN?

- The course provides you with a unique opportunity to discuss in depth the ways and means to enhance the positive impact of business and to minimize and resolve the difficulties to which business operations may give rise.
- You can learn in a flexible way through the combination of online resources on good practices and case studies, 'real time' interactive sessions led by highly experienced trainers, individual and collaborative group exercises using the ITCILO e-campus platform
- You will be connected with various actors from other countries on these topics and exchange with them in a virtual international setting
- You can engage with subject matter experts from the ILO who will provide support and professional guidance during the course
- You will receive an ITCILO certificate of participation upon successful completion of the course.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The course will be offered online through the ITCILO e-campus (https://ecampus.itcilo.org/) over a period of 4 weeks from 11 May to 5 June 2020, for an estimated total of 30 learning hours.

The course consists of three components:

- Online learning: Flexible (asynchronous) self-guided online learning on e-campus
- 'Real time' learning: Live interactive sessions through webinar and engaging video presentations by highly experienced trainers, blended with individual and collaborative group exercises, peer-to-peer assessment and online technical forums on e-campus
- Assignments: You will be required to complete five short assignments and one end of course assignment (Individual or collective in the case of country delegations) on the promotion and application of the ILO MNE Declaration in your national context. Each assignment will receive personalized feedback. Participants who successfully complete all assessments and the final assignment will receive a Certificate of participation.

Please note learning materials and tuition will be offered online in English and access to a computer with internet is essential.
