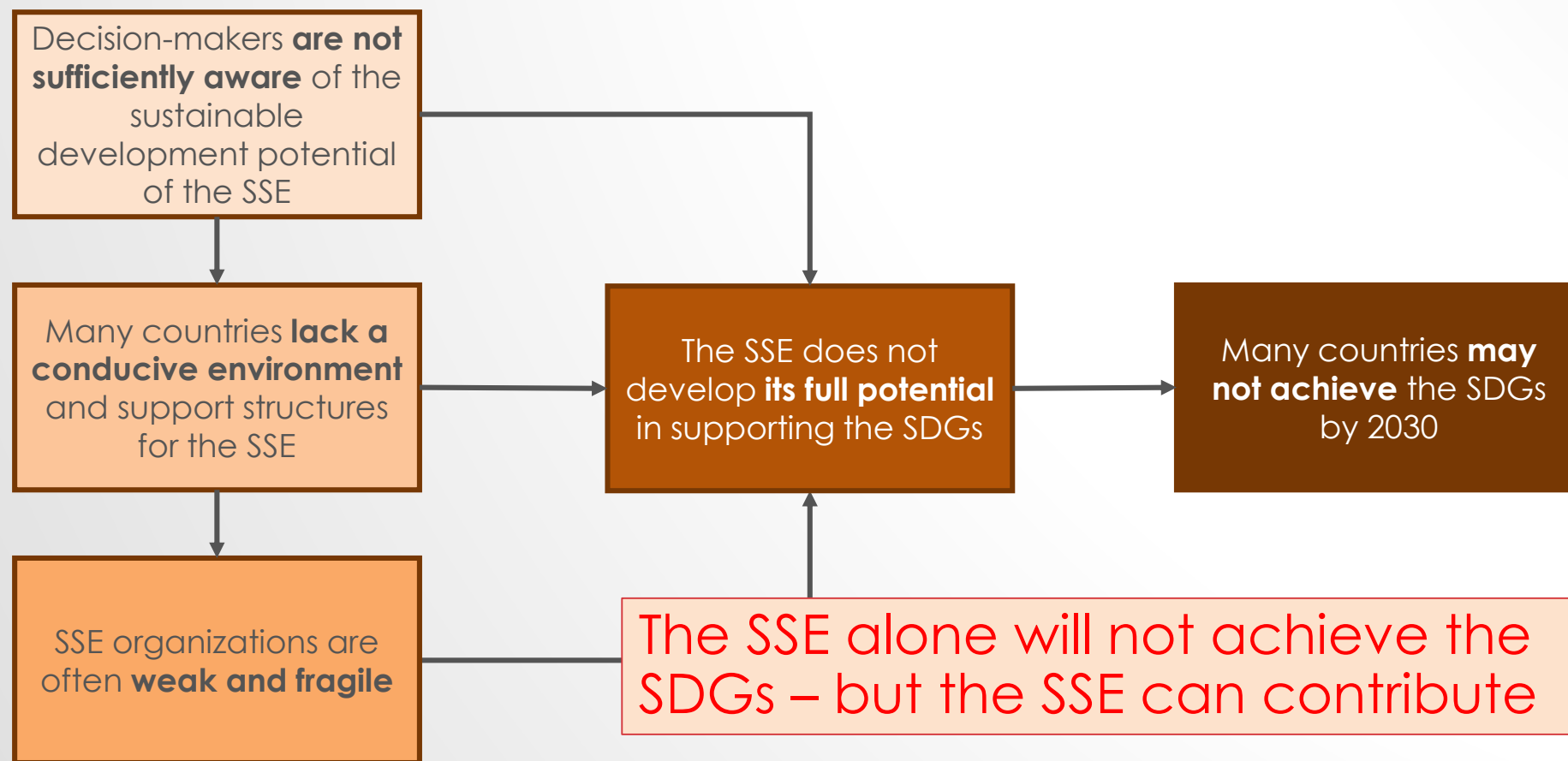




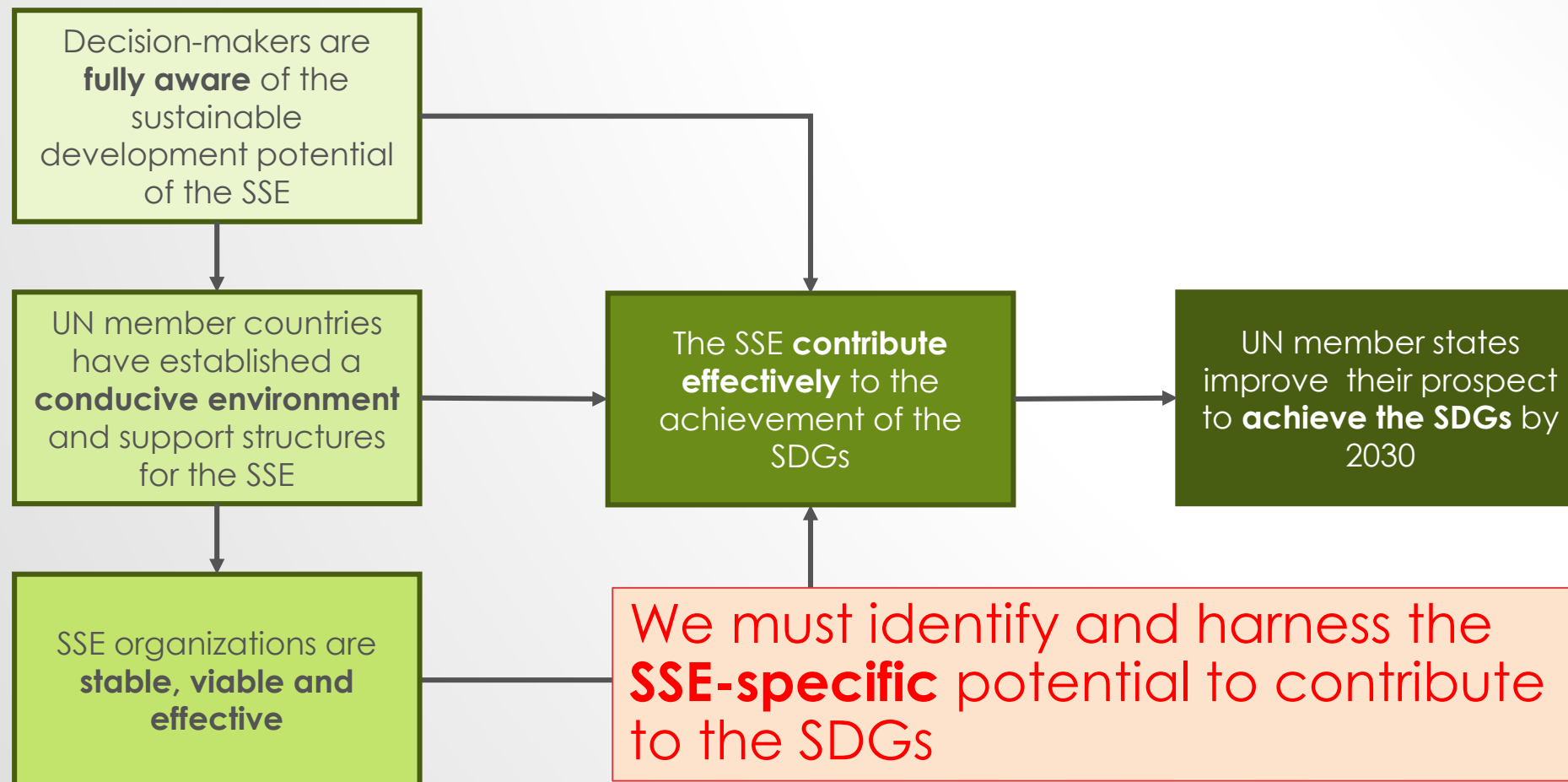

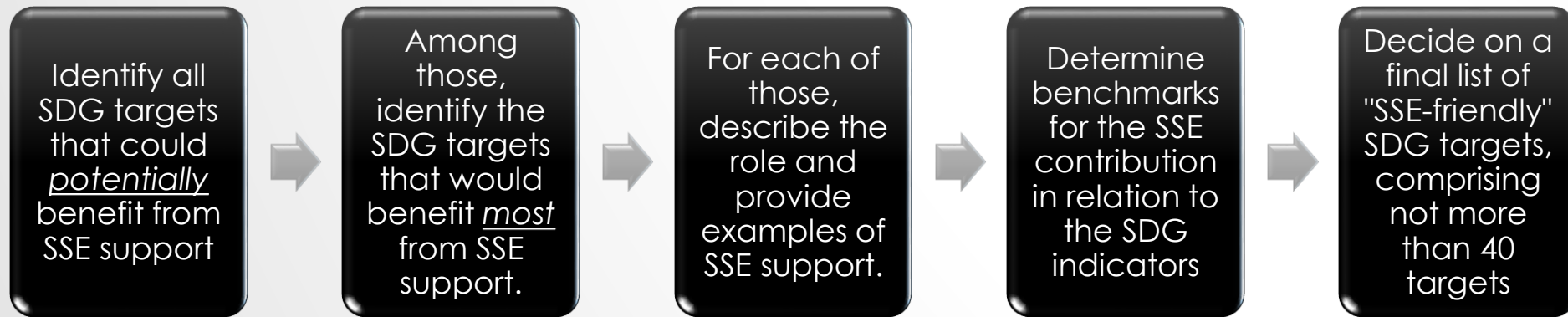
SELECTION OF PILOT COUNTRIES

- Willingness of the national governments to develop an SSE policy and/or legislation;
- Role and place of the SSE the national development plan;
- Interest of the UN Resident Coordinator and the members of the UN country team in the SSE;
- Role and place of the SSE in the country's UNSDF;
- Existence of ongoing SSE projects;
- Interest of development partners in supporting SSE initiatives in the respective country.

UNTFSSSE COMPARITIVE ADVANTAGE

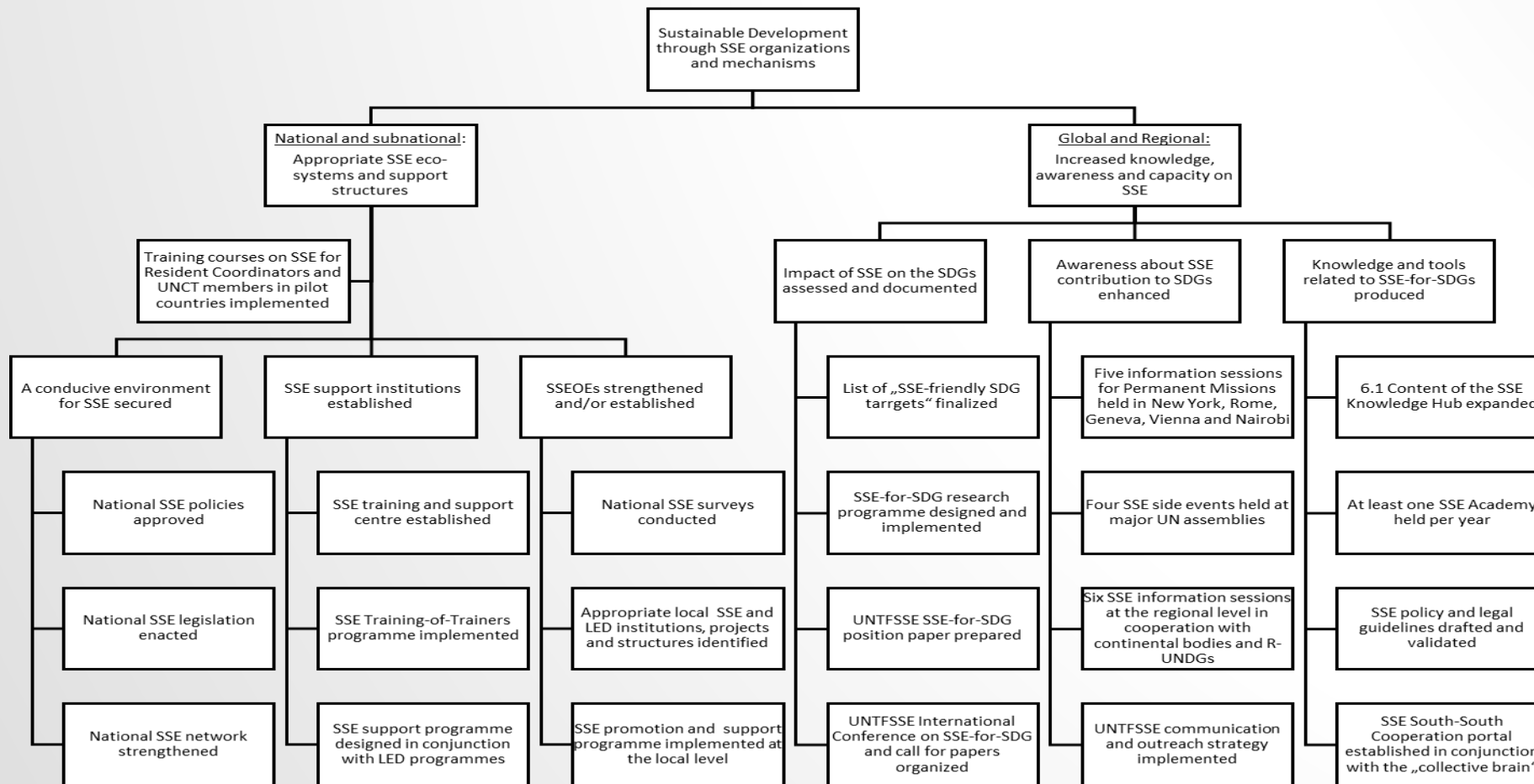
- A self-initiated partnership: delivering as one bottom-up;

PRINCIPAL PROJECT OUTPUTS

National/Local Level

- 3 national SSE policies, laws networks and support centres;
- 3 national SSE surveys conducted;
- 60 local support institutions capacitated;
- SSE challenge of 0.6 million \$ fund established
- 600 SSE organizations with 12,000 members supported

Global Level

- 6 SSE-for-SDG research projects completed;
- International SSE-for-SDG conferences organized;
- 15 SSE information sessions for decision-makers held;
- SSE knowledge hub expanded;
- At least one SSE academy held per year;
- SSE policy and legal guidelines drafted
