Hosted and coordinated by the Employment, Labour Markets and Youth Branch (EMPLAB/EMPLOYMENT)

October 2023

58 questionnaires were received from IDAG members and their networks. The responses of questions 5-7 yielded more than 1,400 entries and provided a general view of the ongoing work of the ILO on youth employment. Other Questions included examples of ongoing projects, good examples of youth employment initiatives, target groups, resources, etc. (see questionnaire).
