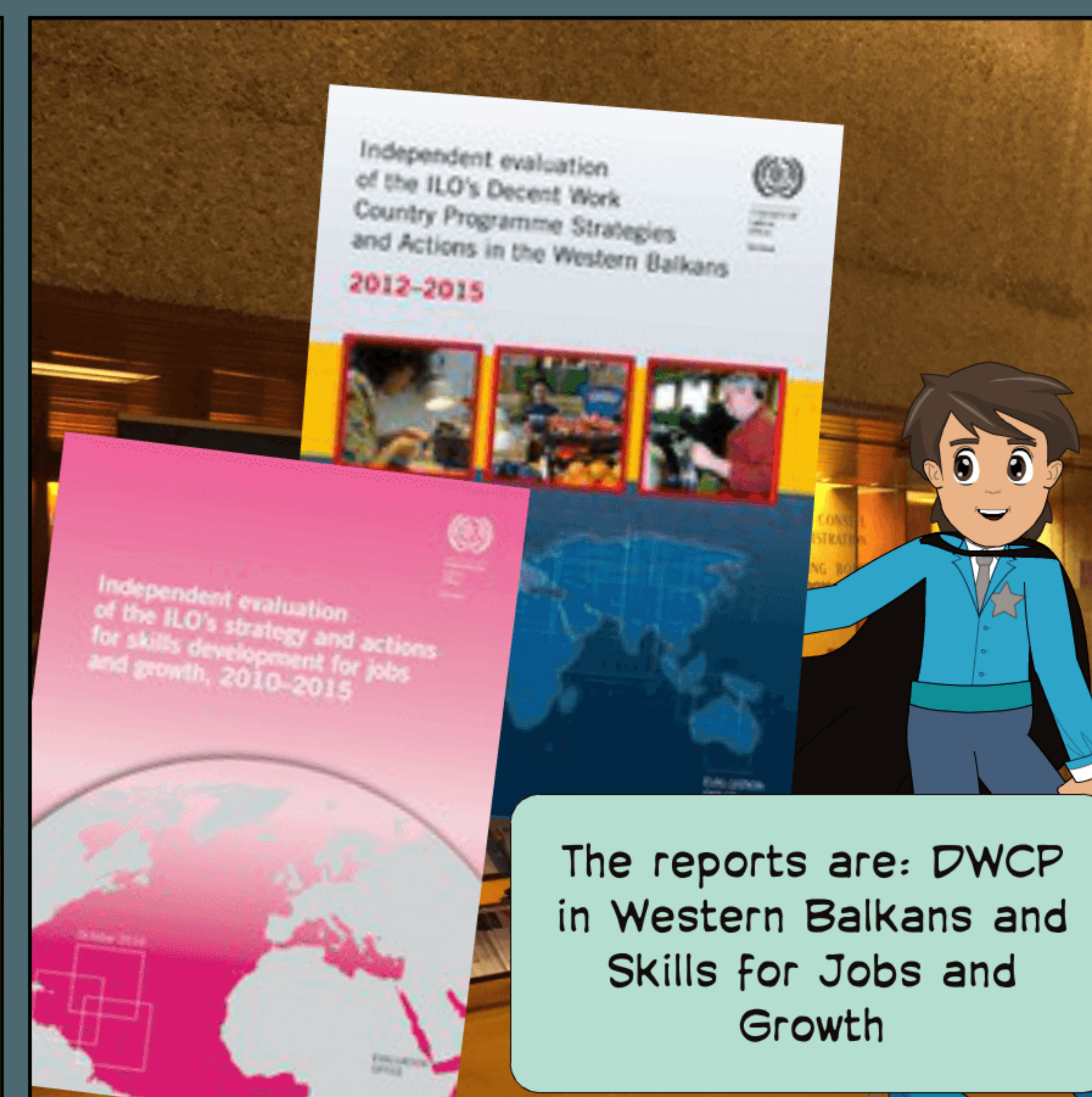

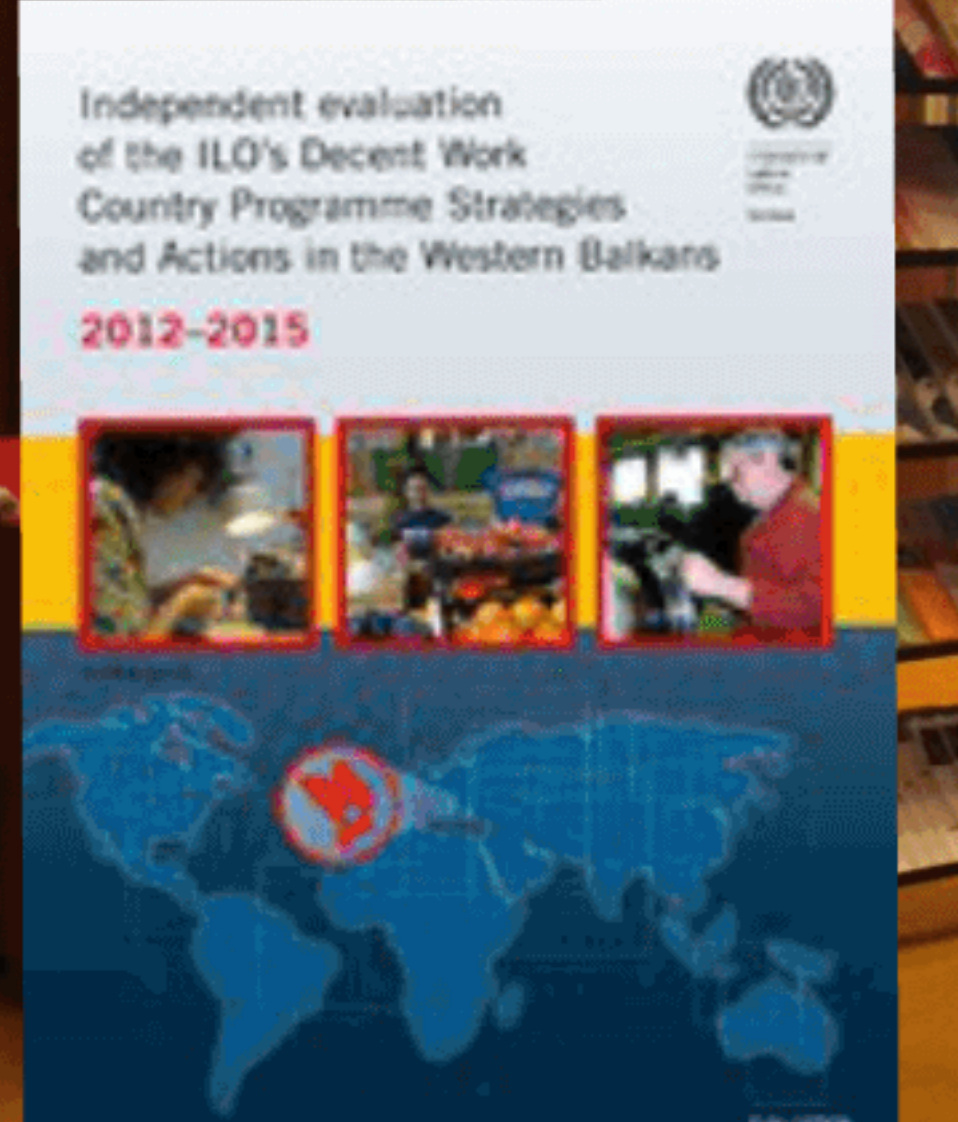
Independent evaluation of the ILO's strategy and actions for skills development for jobs and growth, 2010-2015

The reports are: DWCP in Western Balkans and Skills for Jobs and Growth



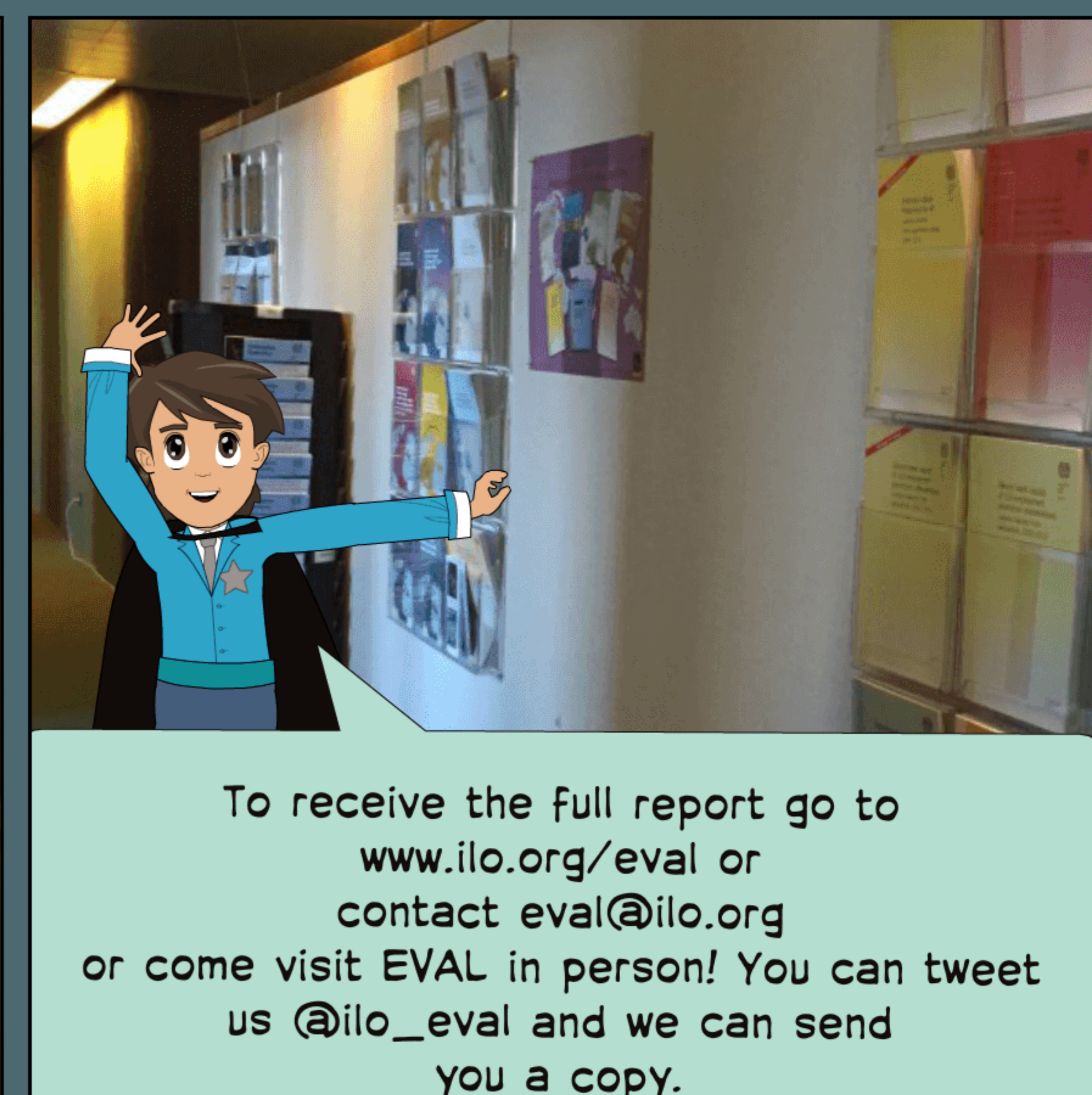
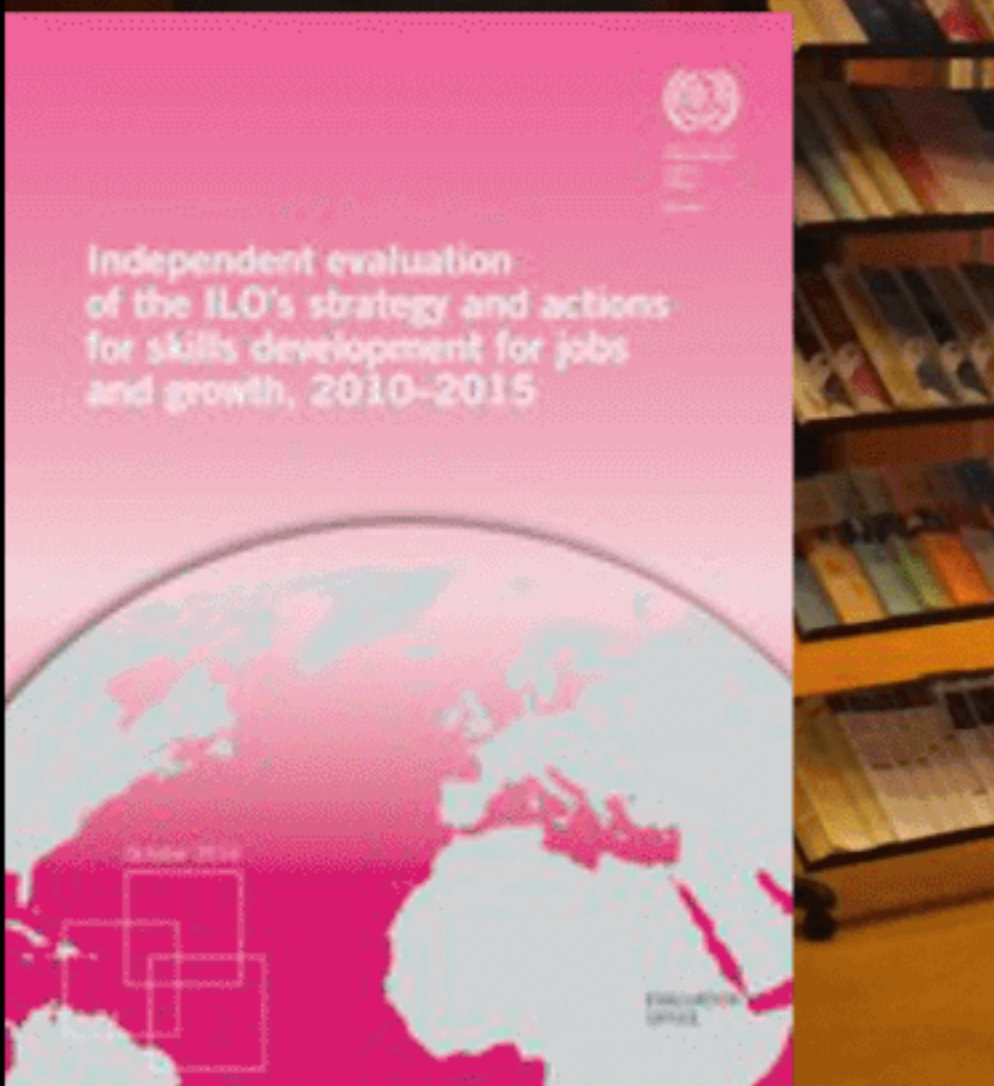
The Western Balkans evaluation covered Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Serbia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia

One of the main recommendations was for more stakeholder participation in all programme cycles



The Skills report contains case studies from Armenia, Bangladesh, Russia, Viet Nam, Uruguay, Zambia and Zimbabwe
