Objective

The Evaluation Office (EVAL) of the International Labour Organization is seeking expressions of interest (EOI) from qualified individuals to expand its pool of national evaluation consultants.

National evaluation consultants will be expected to support a long-term data collection process as part of institutional and decentralized portfolio of evaluations. National evaluation consultants will support evaluation scoping, in-country data collection (on-site field visits, meetings, discussions, and interviews with stakeholders) and reporting, as required. Detailed TORs will be provided for each assignment.

Competencies

- Adequate contextual knowledge of the UN and the ILO.
- Prior knowledge of the ILO's roles and activities. Prior experience evaluating ILO's projects is an asset.
- Proven experience in conducting data collection, including interviews and focus group discussions for evaluation processes.
- Expertise in qualitative and quantitative evaluation methods and an understanding of issues related to validity and reliability.
- Highly skilled to deliver within short timeframes.
- Excellent social, communication and reporting skills.
- Demonstrated written and oral communication skills in the local language.
