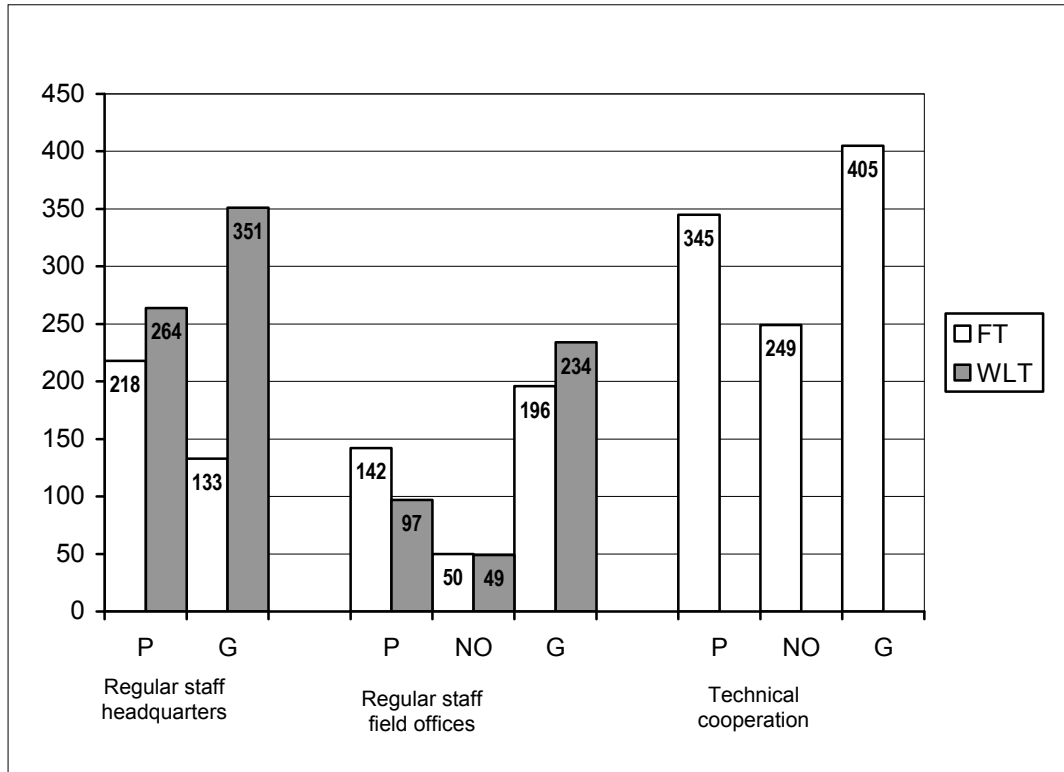

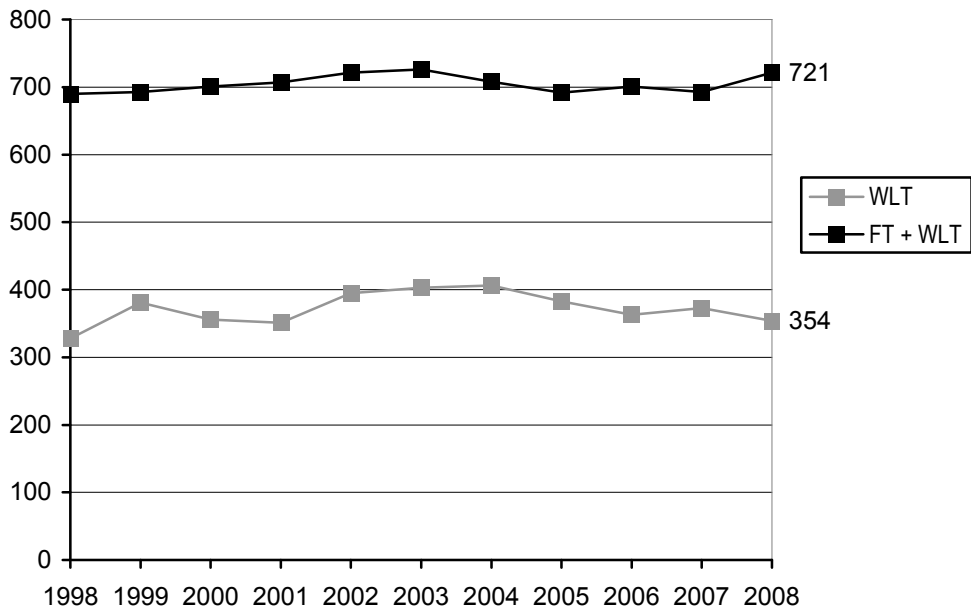

**Chart II. Number of Professional and higher category staff by type of contract from 31 December 1998 to 31 December 2008 (regular staff)**

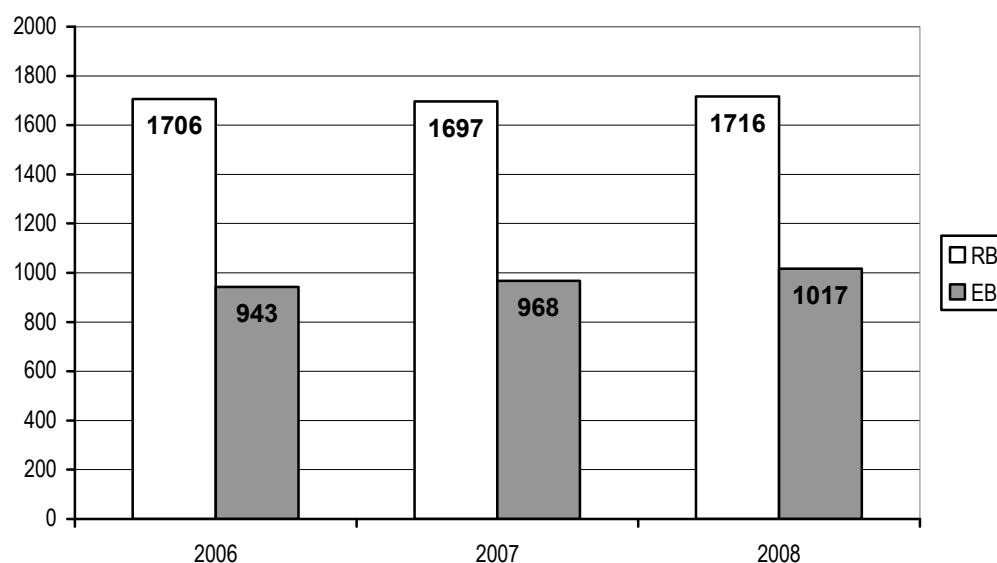

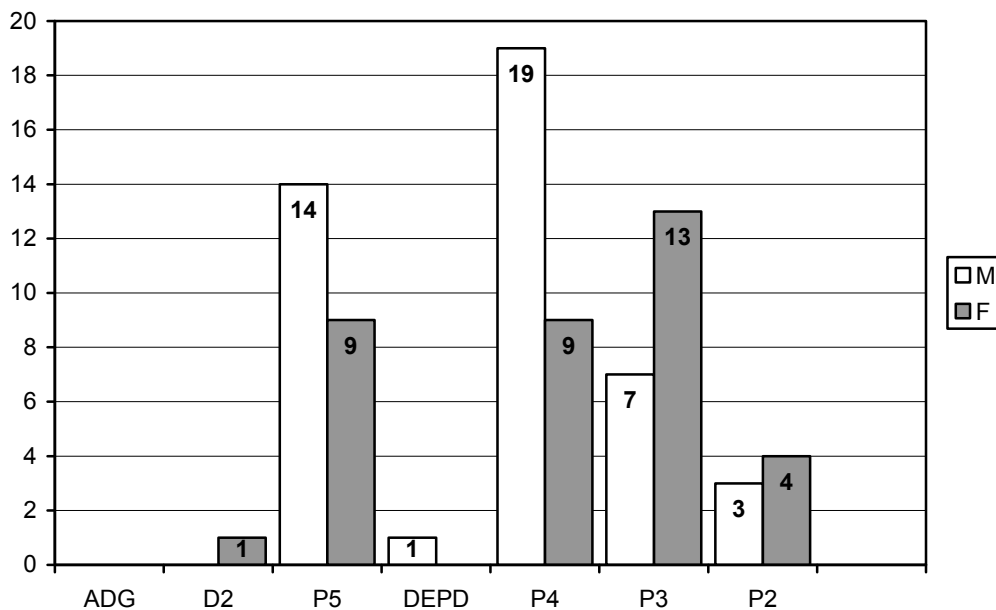

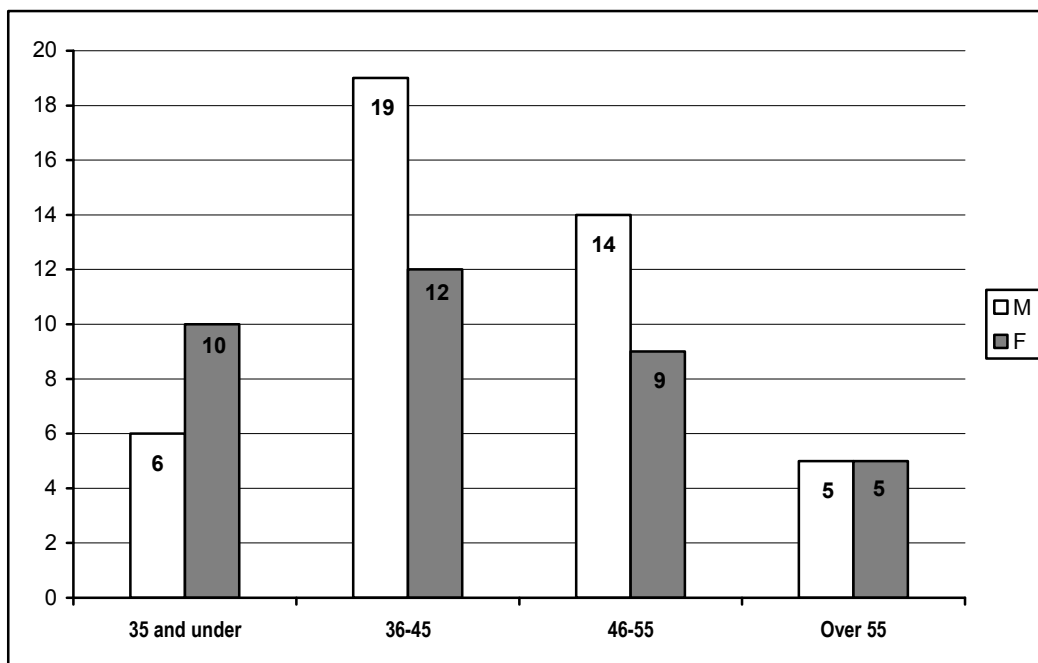

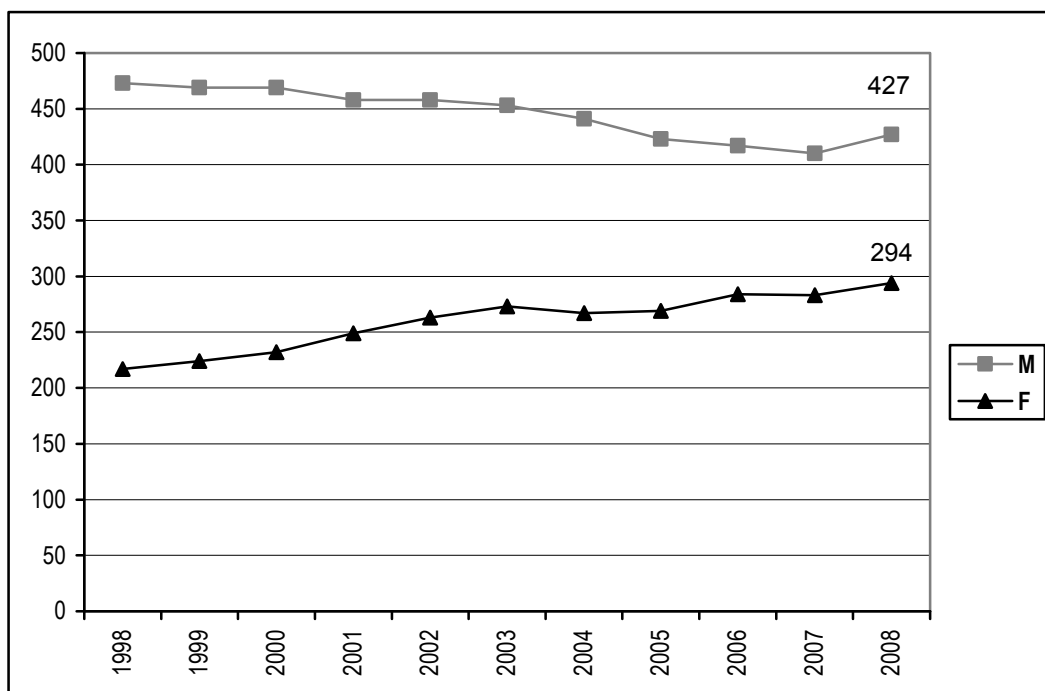

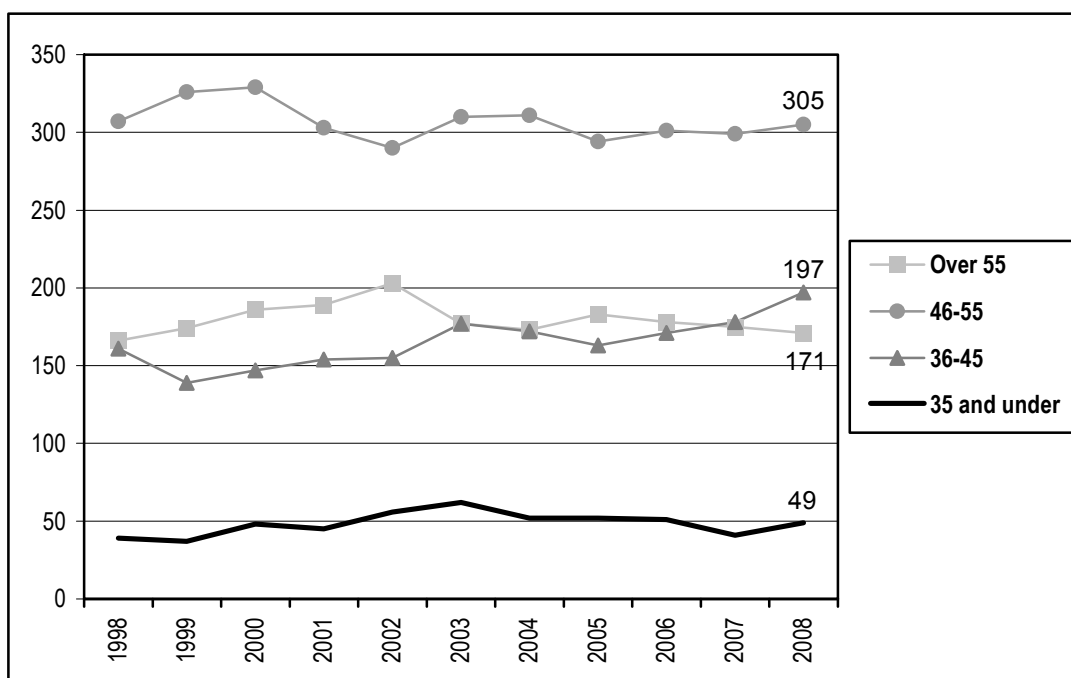
