Corrigendum

The Office commentary concerning question 2(d), on page 12, should read as follows:

“The overwhelming majority of respondents agree with this statement.

In light of the replies received, and in order to keep the Preamble short and concise, the Office proposes to merge the text of question 2(d) and the text of question 2(h) into point 3(d) of the proposed Conclusions.”

The second sentence of the comment from the Government of Austria concerning question 11(g) should read as follows:

“Should transitional governments and other conflict parties be included in reintegration measures and integrated into the labour market?”

The Office commentary concerning question 15(a), on page 63, should read as follows:

“All replies received but one supported this point.

Taking up the suggestions received, the Office proposes to include a reference to training in point 19(a) of the proposed Conclusions.”

The Office commentary concerning question 15(b), on page 64, should read as follows:

In light of the replies received, the Office proposes to include a reference to gender in the chapeau of point 19 of the proposed Conclusions, and suggests a slight rewording in point 19(b).”
