International Labour Conference - 111th Session, Geneva, 2023

Resolution concerning the prompt ratification of the Safe and Healthy Working Environment (Consequential Amendments) Convention, 2023 (No. 191)

(12 June 2023)

The General Conference of the International Labour Organization, meeting in Geneva at its 111th Session, 2023,

Recalling the decision to amend paragraph 2 of the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work (1998) so as to include a safe and healthy working environment in the ILO's framework of fundamental principles and rights at work,

Recalling the adoption of the Safe and Healthy Working Environment (Consequential Amendments) Convention, 2023 (No. 191), at its 111th Session, 2023,

Considering that the prompt and widespread ratification of the Safe and Healthy Working Environment (Consequential Amendments) Convention, 2023 (No. 191), is desirable in order to maintain coherence in the body of international labour standards by aligning references within them to fundamental principles and rights at work with the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work (1998), as amended in 2022,

- Calls for the prompt and widespread ratification of the Safe and Healthy Working Environment (Consequential Amendments) Convention, 2023 (No. 191), in particular from States parties to the Maritime Labour Convention, 2006, as amended, having regard to Article XIV of the latter;
- 2. Invites the Governing Body to request the Director-General to report on the state of ratification of the Safe and Healthy Working Environment (Consequential Amendments) Convention, 2023 (No. 191), at appropriate intervals.
