FIRST ITEM ON THE AGENDA

**Approval of the minutes of the
296th Session of the Governing Body**

1. The draft minutes of the 296th Session were distributed to allow Members who wished to make corrections to submit these to the Office.
2. At midday on Friday, 10 November, the following corrections had been received:

Paragraph 37, add a new final sentence to read: “For these reasons he believed that a culture of complete compliance with the law would make matters easier for the Government.”

Insert a new paragraph 69, as follows:

“In Case No. 2441, on Indonesia, the Committee urged the Government to cease harassing trade union officials and initiate an independent investigation forthwith. Mr. Daud Sukanto, the trade union leader dismissed for advising his members to reject a proposed wage increase as too low, should be reinstated. Section 158(1)(f) of the Manpower Act of 2003 should be reviewed to prevent the term “gross misconduct” from including legitimate trade union activities. The Government should avail itself of ILO technical assistance.”

3. *Subject to the above corrections, the Governing Body may no doubt wish to approve the minutes of the 296th Session.*
