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GLOBAL MEDIA COMPETITION 2020

ON FAIR RECRUITMENT & LABOUR MIGRATION

- ▶ The Global Media Competition aims to recognize and promote quality reporting on labour migration and fair recruitment issues.
- ▶ The 2020 competition will award two “published media pieces” as well as two “synopses”.

DEADLINE ON 31.10.2020

HOW CAN I APPLY?

Submit your entry via the online form by 31 October 2020, at ilo.org/labourmigration

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS ?

Professional journalists can submit a media piece in the following categories: **published media piece** or **synopsis**. Students could submit a media piece only in the **synopsis** categorie. Media pieces could be a written press, photo essay, multimedia, video or radio. The piece must have been published after 1 November 2019, and be submitted in English, French or Spanish (translations will be accepted).

WHAT IS THE PRIZE ?

Award winners will be able to choose from: a cash prize: \$1,200 for the published media piece, and \$500 for the synopsis OR a fellowship prize: participation in a ITC-Turin training course on labour migration (or a related topic).

Winners will be announced on 18 December 2020, International Migrants Day. Winning entries will be featured on the ILO website and will be widely disseminated by the ILO and competition partners as an example of quality journalism.
