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# EU-ILO Project Steering Committee

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## ▶ Stakeholders' and beneficiaries' evaluation of Project implementation in 2020

Main results of the Project Evaluation Survey (based on the responses of 91 project beneficiaries and stakeholders, out of a sample of 2,000), conducted between 25 and 31 December 2020):

- ▶ Overall evaluation: 4.5 (out of 5)
- ▶ Contribution to improve situation in Ukraine: 4.5
- ▶ Awareness of project activities: 4.1
- ▶ Quality of Project communication: 4.6

## ► Occupational Safety and Health (OSH)

### ► 4 sets of technical recommendations:

- 2 on the ME draft Law “On OSH” (February 2021 and June 2021);
- 2 on the draft legal act transposing EU Dir. 92/58/EEC, on safety and/or health signs at work (March 2021 and June 2021).

### ► Advocacy:

- Tripartite workgroup consultations;
- Several technical meetings;
- Participation in several stakeholders’ webinars/conferences to advocate project technical recommendations;
- Publication of 2 Articles (January 2021 and May 2021) in specialized OSH magazines advocating project recommendations regarding the draft Law on OSH.

## ► COVID-19 and World OSH Day 2021

- Translation into Ukrainian and dissemination among national stakeholders of all ILO materials on World OSH Day 2021 on “Anticipate, prepare and respond to crises: Invest now in resilient OSH systems”
- New materials on OSH in times of COVID-19 available in Ukrainian: control checklists for construction and logging activity, WHO-ILO Interim guidance for health workers, ILO Practical guide “Safe Return to Work: Ten Action Points”, ILO brief on Social dialogue on OSH; and “Safe Work Australia” guide on “How do I set up a workstation at home?”.
- Over 500 health workers participated in the joint WHO/EU-ILO Project webinar “COVID-19: OSH for health workers”.
- Project participated and/or supported several events commemorating the World OSH Day 2021:
  - Online conference organized by SLS and OSH Magazine (3,500 participants)
  - Webinar organized by the trade union of railway, transport and construction workers (120 participants)
  - Online marathon of best practices “Safety at every enterprise - 2021”, organized by ESOSH and OSH Magazine (400+ participants)
- Publication of 1 article (May 2021) in a specialized OSH magazine advocating project recommendations on “Investing in Resilient OSH Systems”

## ► Labour relations

- Provision of technical recommendations to 5 draft laws:
  - Employment relationship (Nos. 5054, 5054-1)
  - Non-standard forms of employment (Nos. 5161, 5161-1)
  - Deregulation of employment relationship (No. 5388)
- Advocacy:
  - Technical assistance to the draft of 4 formal opinions of the VRU Committee on Euro-Integration (VRU-CEUI), on alignment of draft Laws 5054, 5054-1, 5161, and 5161-1 with EU Acquis and AA (Committee's request).
  - Advocacy of Project recommendations within several meetings of the competent VRU Committees:
    - VRU Committee of Social Policy and Veteran's Rights meeting (12/4/2021), to discuss the draft Laws 5054 and 5054-1;
    - VRU-CEUI meeting (14/4/2021), to discuss its formal opinion on alignment of draft Laws 5054 and 5054-1 with EU Acquis and AA;
    - VRU-CEU meeting (19/5/2021), to discuss its formal opinion on alignment of draft Laws 5161 and 5161-1 with EU Acquis and AA.
  - Participation in several stakeholders' webinars/conferences to advocate project technical recommendations.

## ► Labour inspection

- 2 sets of technical recommendations on the alignment of 2 draft legal acts, with ILO C81 and C129:
  - Technical recommendation on Section VIII – Final Provisions of the ME draft Law on OSH, aimed at amending the Code of Labour Laws” chapter on labour inspection (Chapter XVIII – Supervision (Control) of Compliance with the Labour Legislation);
  - Technical recommendation on ME draft Law “On Amending Some Legislative Acts on the Procedure of State Supervision (Control) of Compliance with the Labour Legislation”.
- Advocacy:
  - Tripartite WG meeting to discuss the draft law on state supervision of compliance with the labour legislation (15/5/2021);
  - Technical meetings to discuss alignment with ILO C81 and C129;
  - Advocacy meetings with several stakeholders.
- SLS joined IALI (International Association of Labour Inspection), on 15 June 2021;
- SLS Institutional campaign: SLS Institutional Communication situation analysis and training needs assessment of SLS staff on Communication concluded, presented and endorsed. Next: strategy; implementation plan; communication tools; and Programmes and supporting materials for the trainings

## ▶ Undeclared Work (UDW)

- ▶ The National Action Plan to Reduce UDW 2021 (NAP-2021) was adopted on 27 April 2021, by the multilateral national workgroup, led by SLS and endorsed by the Committee on Labour Relations and Labour Market of the NTSEC;
- ▶ 83% (15 out of 18) of its measures were foreseen in the Draft National Action Plan to Fight UDW 2018 (DNAP-2018) supported by the previous EU-ILO Project. Overall, 70% of the measures of the DNAP-2018 are either contained on the NAP-2021 (42%); or are already implemented/being implemented (28%)
- ▶ Over 3,7 million persons learned about UDW within the “GO TO LIGHT!” awareness-raising campaign.
- ▶ Around 220,000 undeclared workers were regularized in 2020 as a result of SLS information and inspection visits, within the scope of the “G To Light” campaign and about 49,000 between January and April 2021.
- ▶ The plan for implementation of the “Go To Light” campaign in 2021 was presented and endorsed.



## ► What's next? Expected deliverables July - December 2021

- **OSH:** (1) Advocacy of Technical recommendations on draft law on OSH and draft legal act transposing EU OSH Directive one safety and health signs; (2) Technical support to the drafting of national legal acts transposing 5 EU individual OSH Directives (PPEs, temporary or mobile construction sites, work equipment, workplaces, and explosive atmospheres).
- **LABOUR RELATIONS:** (1) Advocacy of provided technical recommendations to draft Laws 5054, 5054-1, 5161, 5161-1 and 5388; (2) Technical support to the drafting of the national legal act transposing Directive 2003/88/EC (on working time).
- **LABOUR INSPECTION:** (1) Advocacy of already provided technical recommendations; (2) Development of SLS Institutional Communication Campaign Strategy, Implementation Plan and training programmes and materials.
- **UDW:** To continue the support to SLS on the implementation of the second phase of the “Go To Light” awareness-raising campaign.
